NOTICE.

THE Prints, of which MESSRS. SOTHEY AND WILKINSON now submit a Catalogue, have been collected as the basis of a more extended Cabinet projected by the Proprietor. Although not offering any pretensions to completeness in any one division of Chalcographic Art, they may yet be allowed in their combination to present various attractions to the Connoisseur, and to furnish many valuable illustrations of the History of Art, both in England and on the Continent of Europe.

The most important specimens have been obtained from the different distinguished Collections which, during a considerable series of years, have been dispersed either in London or in Paris. Among them will be found some ancient examples of which no other impression is at present known to exist, and which consequently are not merely worthy of the attention of the Amateur, but may be said to deserve a place in more important public Museums. Of those which are next in rarity, the impressions are in several instances acknowledged by competent authorities to be superior to any others known. Those Prints which, from their recent publication, are more generally accessible, will be almost invariably found to be in the earliest proof state, and in unexceptionable condition, having been selected by the proprietor with great care from the Stocks of the Publishers, or chosen for him by persons of unquestioned judgment in this department of art. It will hardly escape observation that, among this class of prints, several of the examples are in *UNIQUE*, or *almost unique* states. A leading object in the formation of this department of the collection has been to preserve a record of the principal works of British Artists, and at the same time to illustrate the progress of Engraving in this kingdom. Accordingly, the best productions of Woollett, Browne, Earlom, and others, occupy a prominent place in the list; while among the Modern Artists will be found those who have most satisfactorily rendered the pictures of Wilkie, Landseer, Leslie, Newton, Turner, and other eminent painters of our day.

The idea, of which this assemblage of Engravings furnishes but an imperfect outline, having been abandoned, Messrs. Sotheby and Wilkinson confidently invite the attention of Amateurs and the Trade to the property which is now placed in their hands, and which they have no hesitation in saying, if more limited in extent than some which they have had the honour of submitting to public competition, is in some of its features quite worthy of comparison with any that have passed through their hands, and contains many objects which they can never hope again to offer for sale.

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ERRATUM.

Lot 906 has, through inadvertence, been attributed to Longhi. It is in reality the work of RAFFAELLE MORGHEN, and was never completed, the copper having been lost, as related by Palmerini, who attests the extreme rarity of the etching.
